

for NonProfits volunteers and other non-profit organizations are notified of the availability of the program. During this reporting period, 10 Forum for NonProfits volunteers have participated in the program. This training would better enable the Forum for NonProfits to refer candidates for broadcast positions. Participants become familiar with how we run our radio stations and are specifically asked to refer candidates to us to fill job vacancies at the station employment unit.

(d) Initiative: Educational Assistance Program

For approximately the first 5 months of the reporting period, Beasley Broadcasting offered educational assistance to employees in the form of partial tuition reimbursement to enable station personnel to acquire skills that could qualify them for higher level positions.

(e) Initiative: Participation in Events or Programs Sponsored by Educational Institutions Relating to Career Opportunities in Broadcasting

On August 31, 2009, the Employment Unit's Operations Manager conducted a 2 hour workshop in conjunction with the Connecticut School of Broadcasting. The workshop informed students of the current trends and job opportunities in AM radio and was conducted at the Employment Units offices in Boca Raton, Florida. The Employment Unit designed its participation in the workshop to further the goal of disseminating information as to employment opportunities in AM radio to job candidates who might otherwise be unaware of such opportunities.
